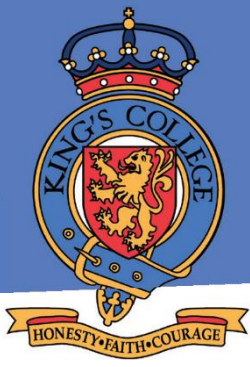

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. INFORMATION

BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L., located at: Glorieta del Reino Unido, 5 – 03008 ALICANTE. Tax Number: B81447591

2. LEGAL REGULATION APPLICABLE TO THE CONTRACT AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE GENERAL CONDITIONS

These General Conditions are subject to whatever results from the application of the Royal Legislative (R.D.L.) 1/2007 of November 16th, which approves the revised text of the General Law for the Defence of Consumers and Users, Las 7/1998 of April 13th, on General Conditions of Contracting, and the Civil Code. The present General Conditions, signed by the contracting parties, will be incorporated into all contracts of the British School of Alicante, S.L. Programme, the object of which are the programmes contained in the information sheets and are binding on the parties, together with the particular conditions agreed in the contract and those which may be established in each programme. .

3. REGISTRATION, PRICE AND PAYMENT

In order to register for the chosen program, you must request the registration form from British School of Alicante, S.L, fill it in and send it back to British School of Alicante, S.L, together with the corresponding reservation fee. Any request for enrolment in any of our programs must be accompanied by a payment for reservation fee to the value of: €180. The amount paid on account will be deducted from the total price of the Program. The payment of the amounts referred to in the previous point should be made to the following account (always indicating the name and surname of the participant):

No programme registration will be processed unless accompanied by proof of payment. The balance of the price of the contracted Programme must be paid 30 days before the start of that programme. Any failure to pay, both in time and method, will be considered as a waiver of the pupil to attend the course. Registrations made less than 30 days prior to the Programme start date must pay the full amount of the chosen programme at the time of registration. Registrations are personal and non-transferable.

4. CANCELLATION, NO PRESENTATION AND/OR ABANDONMENT OF THE PROGRAM BY THE CUSTOMER

In the event that the customer decides to cancel the contracted Program, they must notify KING'S COLLEGE INTERNATIONAL, S.L in writing. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the customer must pay BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L the amount corresponding to any damages caused, including all types of expenses incurred by BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L, up to the current date. In order to inform the customer of the amount of retentions or charges to be made by withdrawal they shall amount to:

- 25% of the programme price, if the cancellation occurs between 44 and 30 days from the course start date
- 50% of the programme price, if the cancellation occurs between 29 and 10 days from the course start date.
- 75% of the programme price, if the cancellation occurs within 9 days prior to the course start date.
- 100% in case of a no-show at departure.

The reservation fees indicated in section two (2) of these general conditions must be paid to BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S. L. in any case and, likewise, will not be refunded in any case, except if the cancellation insurance is taken out. Notwithstanding, if the customer withdraws from the contract during a period of 7 days from its execution, BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. will return them the amounts paid without withholding expenses. The customer shall not be entitled to any refund if they, their parents or their legal guardians voluntarily leave the Programme once said Programme has commenced.

5. ALTERATIONS AND OCCURRENCES IN THE PROGRAMME

KING' S COLLEGE INTERNATIONAL S. L. undertakes to provide customers with all contracted services contained within the programme, with the stipulated conditions and characteristics. Notwithstanding, the following considerations should be taken into account: a) In the event that, prior to the start of the Programme, KING'S COLLEGE INTERNATIONAL S.L. are forced to significantly alter any essential part of the contract, including the price, they must immediately bring it to the attention of the customer. The latter may choose to terminate the contract without charge or accept an amendment to the contract. In the latter case BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. will specify any modifications introduced and their repercussion on the price of the Programme. (b) The customer shall notify their decision as soon as possible and, in any case, within three days of being notified of the change in the Programme. In the event that the customer does not notify BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. of their decision within the three-day period, it will be understood that they choose to terminate the Programme. c) In the event that BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L. are obliged to cancel any of its Programmes due to cases not attributable to the customer, or in the event that the customer chooses to terminate the contract under the protection of the provisions of paragraphs a) and b), BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. will offer the customer an alternative Programme of equal or higher quality, or will reimburse the customer for the total amount paid for the Programme. In addition, in such cases KING'S COLLEGE INTERNATIONAL S.L. shall indemnify the customer for breach of contract with the following amounts:

- 25% of the programme price if the cancellation occurs between 44 and 30 days from the course start date.
- 50% of the programme price, if the cancellation occurs between 29 and 10 days from the course start date.
- 75% of the programme price, if the cancellation occurs within 9 days prior to the course start date.
- 100% in case of a no-show at departure.

d) There will be no obligation on the part of BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. to indemnify the customer when the programme is cancelled due to reasons of force majeure. e) There will be no obligation on the part BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. to compensate customers in the event that the programme cancellation is due to not reaching the minimum number of people required (10 participants) for the effective realisation of the same. In such cases BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. shall notify the customer in writing that the minimum number of participants has not been reached and that the programme has therefore been cancelled. In this case, the customer is entitled to a refund of all amounts they have paid for the programme. f) Any differences and/or claims that, in the opinion of the customers, arise during the progress of the contracted Programme shall be brought to the attention of the Organisation responsible for the Programme, in order to offer a satisfactory solution immediately. In the event that the solution proposed by the Organisation responsible for the Programme being conducted is not satisfactory to the customer, the latter shall have a period of one month to submit a claim in writing to BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. They, having obtained the relevant documentation, would in turn have a period of one month to reply to the customer's complaint. If the solution proposed by BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. was also not satisfactory, the customer may initiate any corresponding actions.

6. PRACTICES AND MANDATORY STANDARDS DURING THE PROGRESS OR THE PROGRAMME

The participant agrees to respect and abide by the course discipline and behaviour rules, both during their stay in the facilities where they receive their lessons, and outside of them. In particular, in relation to opening times of the centre, the obligation of class attendance, meals, rules of coexistence and behaviour with teachers, classmates, and staff employed by BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. and the prohibition of consumption and possession of tobacco, alcohol and drugs. Failure on the part of the participant will result in their expulsion from the course, the expenses of the early return home being paid on their account.

7. AUTHORISATION FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT CONDITIONS

In the event that a pupil of minor age is in a situation needing medical treatment and/or being admitted to hospital and/or in need of surgical intervention and it has not been possible to locate their parents or guardians, BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. is hereby authorised to take the measures it deems most appropriate for the participant's health.

8. MEDICAL, PHARMACOLOGICAL AND/OR SURGICAL TREATMENT

The participant shall inform BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. if they are undergoing any medical and/or pharmacological treatment during the period covered by the chosen programme. It is understood that, at the time of beginning the programme, the participant is in correct physical and mental health to participate in the programme and that the medical information accompanying the programme dossier is true and complete. Otherwise, the company BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE. is exempt from any type of liability arising from the falseness of the information.

9. ELECTRONIC DEVICES

BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L. is not responsible for the loss and/or deterioration of any electronic devices that the participant may bring to the chosen programme.

10. DOCUMENTATION

All participants who contract the programmes of BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. must carry the necessary personal documentation (ID card, health insurance card) in accordance with the laws of the country where the arranged programme will occur. BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. will not accept responsibility for any and all liability or expenses arising from failure to comply on the part of the participant, their parents or guardians.

11. INSURANCE

Participants who enrol in the programmes of BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. can enjoy a fully comprehensive insurance cover according to the conditions of the insurance policy taken out by BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE S.L. and provided by the company Caser.

12. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA AND THE TREATMENT OF IMAGES

12.1 Aim of the programme. BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L., as the data controller, with registered address at Glorieta del Reino Unido, No. 5, 03008 Alicante, informs the signatories of the registration form that their own personal data and, where applicable, that of the respective represented persons, that are requested through the form, as well as those that may be provided subsequently, including those relating to special categories if any, are necessary for compliance with the stipulations of these General Conditions, as well as for the development, control and management of the training activity in which the participant has registered. The signatories guarantee the veracity of the data provided at all times and undertake to communicate promptly to BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L. any variation thereof. The legal basis for the processing of personal data is the execution of these General Conditions, as well as the fulfilment of legal obligations corresponding to BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L. and the consent given by the signatories. If the signatories do not consent to the processing of their data, the participant will not be able to enjoy the training activity. In addition, in the event that the signatories check the boxes enabled for the purpose, they expressly authorise (i) BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L. so that it can transfer personal data to King's Group, a group company, and (ii) that both companies process the personal data so that either of them can send commercial communications by any means, including telephone, e-mail or equivalent means of communication, about products, services and promotions in the field of educational and cultural services. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the signatories may revoke their express consent for any of the additional purposes envisaged and, in particular, for the receipt of commercial communications, at any time, in writing via email addressed to info.kca@kingsgroup.org

12.2 Data retention. The data provided will be kept for as long as is necessary to ensure compliance with the legal obligations corresponding to BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L.; and beyond, for as long as is required by applicable law.

12.3 Data of third parties. In the event that personal data of third parties is provided, the signatories guarantee to have informed such third parties and to have obtained from them the necessary consent for processing by BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L. for the purposes detailed in this clause. BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L. reserves the right to require signatories, whose documentation includes the processing of data from third parties, to prove that they have complied with the information and consent requirements mentioned above.

- 12.4 The signatories authorise BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L. to transfer personal data through communication at any given time to the entities belonging to the business group of which KCA is a member. Likewise, the collaborating organisations that carry out services related to the content of the training activity and that help BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L. in this sense may have access to the participant's data, in order to process and control the proper development and execution of the training activity.
- 12.5 Security measures. BRITISH SCHOOL OF ALICANTE, S.L. informs you that it has implemented the necessary technical and organisational security measures to guarantee the security of your personal data and avoid its alteration, loss, processing and/or unauthorised access, taking into account the state of the technology, the nature of the data stored and the risks to which it is exposed, whether they come from human action or from the physical or natural environment.
- 12.6 Rights. The signatories may, under the terms established in the data protection regulations in force at any given moment and in accordance with said regulations, revoke at any time the authorisation granted for the processing and transfer of personal data, as well as exercise the rights of access, rectification, deletion, objection, the right to request the limitation of the processing of their personal data, the right to portability and the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority. This can be done by writing to KCA with proof of identity to Glorieta del Reino Unido, 5, 03008, Alicante, or by e-mailing info.kca@kingsgroup.org.
- 12.7 Image KCA informs the signatories and the participant that photographs and recordings of the participant may be made during the enjoyment of the training activity, and that KCA intends to publish such images and/or recordings in conventional and/or electronic media to promote its activities. For this reason, authorisation is requested from the participant or, as the case may be, from their legal representatives, so that KCA, free of charge and without any obligation to pay for it, may use and/or disseminate the image of the participant without any time or territorial limit whatsoever, totally, partially or fragmented, through any form of utilisation (reproduction, distribution, sticking, posting or projection of images, provision of availability, public communication and/or adaptation for commercial purposes) and/or in any dissemination media, marketing media, online reports, press material, newsletters, websites, social networks and/or other similar media on the Internet (all owned by KCA), for the purpose of carrying out any commercial, promotional and/or advertising action of the training activities. In any case, you may at any time revoke your consent in accordance with the applicable image rights regulations.

12. RESOLUTION OF CONFLICTS

Any conflict related to the programs will be resolved by the competent jurisdictional bodies according to the applicable legislation.

13. VALIDITY

The validity of these general conditions will be from January the First, 2019 to December the 31st, 2019 both inclusive.
